

Viewing Authorisation Details in BloodSTAR

BloodSTAR allows nurses to view a patient's **authorisation Details** and **Treatment Plan**. Information available to users includes, authorisation number, authorisation start and end dates, medical condition, current regimen, treating arrangements, planned treatment dates, as well as other important details. Below shows the steps for viewing a patient's authorisation in BloodSTAR.

Confirm a Patient is Authorised to Receive Ig

1. You can see a list of all patients registered to your facility from your home page.


