

BLOODSTAR User Registration NOW OPEN

What is BloodSTAR?

BloodSTAR is Australia's immunoglobulin management system that will go live across the nation from July 2016.

Who needs to register for BloodSTAR?

Prescribers and Nurses* – who manage the treatment of patients requiring immunoglobulin product.

*Prescribers and Nurses working in NSW Health facilities do not need to register at this time

Dispensers – do not need to register for BloodSTAR as they will only access information through BloodNet.

How do I register for BloodSTAR?

Registering is a two-step process:

1. Login to BloodPortal or create a BloodPortal account by clicking on New User? Create an account at <https://portal.blood.gov.au>.
2. Click on the BloodSTAR tile, Request Role, enter in your information, Save, accept the terms and conditions and Submit. (Complete step 2 for each facility at which you work)

Why do I need to register now?

Registering now will help to make the transition and go live of BloodSTAR as smooth as possible.

If you are a Treating Medical Specialist your currently authorised patients will be entered into BloodSTAR for you if;

1. you register at least 8 weeks prior to your State/Territory go live for BloodSTAR,
2. your patients have provided consent (and a copy has been provided to the Australian Red Cross Blood Service)
3. your patient/s have authorisation beyond the go live date, and
4. the treating facility is registered for BloodSTAR.

When will my facility start using BloodSTAR?

After the scheduled go-live date, all authorisation requests for IVIg and SCLg will be submitted via BloodSTAR.
